# ORDER OF REINSTATEMENT OF CERTIFIED NURSING ASSISTANT CERTIFICATE

### I. PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

On or about May 23, 2017, the Maryland Board of Nursing (the "Board") accepted the voluntary surrender of the certificate of Michael Ngu Fomundam (the "Respondent") to practice as a certified nursing assistant ("CNA"), certificate number A00104732, in the State of Maryland. The voluntary surrender was based on the Respondent's guilty plea to Fraud in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree related to my participation in a scheme to defraud the Medicaid program, a crime involving moral turpitude.

## II. CONSIDERATION OF REINSTATEMENT APPLICATION

On or about January 14, 2021, the Respondent submitted a request to the Board to reinstate his certificate to practice as a CNA in the State of Maryland. In support of his reinstatement request, the Respondent submitted a letter requesting reinstatement, evidence of completion of a criminal history records check, letter of reinstatement for participation in Federal health care programs from the Office of the Inspector General, and evidence of completion of a nursing assistant training program. Upon consideration of the materials submitted in support of the Respondent's request for reinstatement, the Board concludes that the Respondent's certificate to practice as a CNA in the State of Maryland shall be reinstated.

**ORDERED** that the Respondent's application for reinstatement of his certificate to practice as a certified nursing assistant in the State of Maryland is hereby **GRANTED**; and it is further

**ORDERED** that the Respondent's license to practice as a certified nursing assistant in the State of Maryland, certificate number A00104732, is **REINSTATED**; and it is further
